

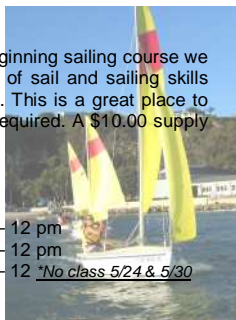
JR. SAILORS SEASIDE ADVENTURE - CLASS

Each day holds a new adventure as we explore different Jr. Sailors activities. Sail, kayak, paddleboard, play boating games and row, or *Focus strictly on sailing and advance your sailing skill level if you have had previous Westwind Jr. Sailors courses. Bring a snack (no glass containers) sunscreen, towel, and a change of clothes daily. Students must pre-register and be "water safe". A \$10.00 supply fee is payable to instructor at first class.

Learning to sail is safe, fun and easy! In this exciting beginning sailing course we cover basic boating safety, basic sloop rigging, points of sail and sailing skills development. Classes are taught in 14' Capri sailboats. This is a great place to start! Students must be "water safe". Pre-registration required. A \$10.00 supply fee is payable to instructor the first day of class.

ADULT SAILING II

This intermediate course is designed for adults who have previous sailing experience in dinghy sailboats. Students will improve basic knowledge, learn more skills and log more sailing time in our 14' Capris. Students must have obtained a "successful completion" card from Adult Sailing I or Women's Sailing IIA, be "water safe" and pre register. A \$10.00 supply fee is payable to instructor the first day of class.

FAMILY SAILING

Let's get the whole family sailing, together! In this class, parents and kids learn to sail together in our 14' boats. Topics we'll cover include basic safety, rigging, points of sail, capsiz practice and basic sailing skills development. Creative water games will help reinforce your sailing skills while keeping it fun. Children may register for this class with a family member or friend who is at least 18 years old. A maximum of 2 registered children per adult is allowed. Students must be "water safe" and pre-register. A \$10.00 supply fee to instructor at 1st class.

PRIVATE /SEMI-PRIVATE SAILING

Private and semi private lessons are available for individuals who just need to refresh their sailing skills or whose personal schedule does not coincide with our regular scheduled courses. Five hours of private lessons or six hours of semi private lessons equal a condensed version of Sailing I, while 10 hours of private / 12 hours semi private complete the Sailing II level. Lessons are scheduled by appointment only and are subject to instructor availability. Phone Westwind Sailing for an appointment.

Adult Private: \$65 / per hr (18 yrs and up, 1 student)
 Adult Semi-Private: \$45 per person, per hour (18 yrs. +, 2-4 students)
 Youth Private: \$50 / per hr (6- 17 yrs, 1 student)
 Youth Semi-Private: \$37 per person, per hour (6-17 yrs, 2-4 students)

SAILING RIDES

Enjoy ocean breezes, sunshine and the thrill of riding the wind. Gather your family and call your friends for the most exciting way to spend your afternoon: on the water... SAILING! We sail 14' Capris and generally can accommodate up to 3 passengers. Active participation is encouraged, but not required. Rides are subject to instructor availability; phone Westwind Sailing for an appointment.. One-hour minimum – ½ hour blocks after the 1st hr

Activities include fun sails and regattas, holiday activities and pizza parties. Members must have obtained a "successful completion" card from JS II, JSDC II or Teen II or equivalent skills to join (skills to be determined by Westwind Instructor). 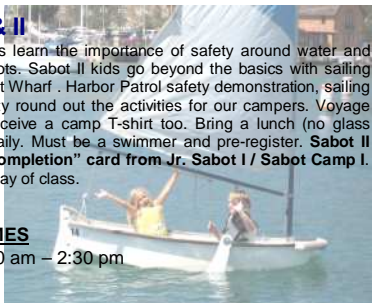
MINI MATES DAY CAMPS
